- iii. Road will not be widened. Another 4-way intersection will be added near Pike
- iv. Joe I., Steve A., Thad S., and other attendees at the 8/22 meeting suggested things such as: roundabout at PD; extending path; lights at Cahill, High Ridge, Post Rd; bike/ped underpass; Bcycle stations
- v. Suggestion that BF draft a statement of support for bike-friendly recommendations for this project.
- vi. We may be able to serve as conduit for grants/investments from foundations as 501c(3)
