# Bike Fitchburg, Inc. Monthly Meeting Minutes

## Monday, 11/28/2022, 6:30-8:00pm, Delta Beer Lab

1) Call to order, roll call, welcome - Tony

In attendance: Tony Hartman, Angie Lucas, Mike Grady, Steve Arnold, Joe Imilkowski, Darryl Jordan, Thad Schumacher, Carol Aspinwall, Bill Jetzer, Kay Lum, Mark Hamilton

2) Approval of past minutes: Oct 24, 2022 Updated minutes approved unanimously

- 3) Treasurer's report Steve
  - a) Our checking account now contains \$18,999.11. Balanced against that are liabilities to four sub-accounts: the JUST Bikes small grants funds of \$1500, the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund of \$14,463.32, Pick Me Up registrations of \$0, and AARP Small Dollar, Big Impact grant funds of \$1000.
    I have also encumbered \$2110.45 to Saris for a repair stand, pump, wheel chock, and two Bike Docks (bike racks). When these ship (lead time at time of order estimated to be twelve weeks), the checking account and the memorial fund liability will be reduced by this amount.
  - b) Our recent checking transactions include a \$15.81 monthly payment to Zoom, \$50 to the Bike League for Bike Fitchburg's own Bicycle Friendly Business application, and \$25 to the Wisconsin Dept. of Financial Institutions for our annual report. We also had a \$265 donation from the American Family Foundation, including \$250 based on Mike's volunteer hours and a \$15 donation from Mike. Thanks, Mike!
  - c) Our savings account received another \$0.05 in interest and now totals \$1801.90.
  - d) Our net worth has increased to \$3837.69 (from \$3663.45).
- 4) Progress on 2023 goals

Bill to work with Steve create toplevel folder with subfolders for each goal. Currently only Steve, Tony, & Bill have write access to the BF google drive. We will work out additional permissions and/or a system for documenting progress.

Tony notes that we need a simple system or it will become a chaotic combination of underused and messy.

#### a) Volunteer Recruitment

Non-board member Carol arrived as we were discussing this topic. Says she can do at least an hour per month in volunteer work. She will show up at our next (Jan) meeting to help us with volunteer recruitment.

#### b) Update & Re-ratify the Bike/Ped Plan

Mark will take this back to the bike committee, and will talk to Phil Grupe and Chad Brecklin

## c) Greenway System - Steve

Just heard from the sign shop doing our "etiquette" signs. Cannonball & Post and Traceway & Fish Hatchery Rd are the demonstration sites. Might not get installed until spring.

## d) BCycle Expansion - McKenzie, Lee

Lee is having a hard time prioritizing BF board duties and we should find a new board member. Perhaps McKenzie will join the board.

Mark: Rollout will be in Mar 2023. TAP grant is in place for phase 2. Will ultimately be 100 bikes in Fitchburg. Goal is to ensure equity (senior center, Allied Dr)

## e) Better-Connected Trail System

Steve: Focus on the 60% "Interested but Concerned" group, who will bike on separated facilities and *protected* bike lanes with physical barrier between bikes & cars.

We should lobby for Vision Zero. It's on the Bicycle Committee's ToDo list – Mark will go to Phil & Chad. Paul Woodard is back in Public Works for ~6 months and may be amenable to biking infrastructure.

#### f) Bike Rodeos / Education & Outreach - Mike

2023 will have 4-5 safety events in the summer (bike rodeos). Looking for different partners (e.g., Wheels for Winners).

Thad, Tony, Steve can host a ride with seniors.

### g) Police Bike Patrol - Tony

Traded calls with Lt. Hartwick, but no real news yet.

  - i) Kay's survey questions for Bike Fitchburg mailing list to gauge interest in types of events
    - 1) Earlier start times?
    - 2) Ride to the border & get a car/van/bus ride back? (Would need trailer to bring bikes back)

Carol suggested a circuit-style route rather than out & back. She also suggested a full moon ride, but that's been attempted and it always lands on the weekend of another big event plus it's cloudy & rainy every year anyway.
