a) Volunteer Recruitment

Craig: Madison Bikes gave a micro-grant (~\$2k) to La Comunidad News to do bike promotion ("culturally relevant content"). Plan is to do 3 videos. Some undocumented Latinos ride bikes because they can't legally get a driver's license.

Craig: Told story about the Biker killed on Mineral Point Rd. Lived at Mayflower Motel, worked at Kwik Trip. Bike saved him money on bus fare.

b) Update & Re-ratify the Bike/Ped Plan

Bicycle Committee discussed this in their June meeting.

Agreed that updates are necessary but didn't get into any specifics.

Julia: Mark H told her we can tweak our current plan rather than start over from scratch.

c) Greenway System - Steve

d) **BCycle Expansion**

Fed Gov't through the MPO for TAP grant, \$250-300k 80/20% split. Mark H and Phil G know more.

Julia got a request for more locations: Library & Senior Center.

Craig: Other entities and municipalities are interested in ride data. Can BF generate any reports?

e) Better-Connected Trail System - Steve

People for Bikes is industry advocacy group. Places for Bikes city ratings. Analyze your openstreetmap data. Fitchburg is 91st percentile. Looks at safe routes (off-road or protected bike lane, 30mph or under buffered,...intersections). Look at point to point between census blocks. Official announcements/results to come this week.

f) Bike Rodeos / Education & Outreach - Mike

Mike is absent; hosting an event at Allied Park tonight.

Co-teaching class with the Bike Fed (Natalie & Caitlin, who do safe routes to school) in Sun Prairie went well and should be a model for a class with the Fitchburg Rec department. Tony: Scott Endl would like BF to add a rodeo in Southdale. Any time of year. Wants more programming over there.

g) Police Bike Patrol - Tony

Tony sent Ned Hartwick an email but hasn't heard anything. Logan Brown is contact. Want the optics.

Julia: PD down to 7 vacancies (from 11). Logan was community officer in NFHR. Want one in

each HNI neighborhood. But PD is short on patrol, so Logan was pulled out of the neighborhood. Sun Prairie & Verona also having problems attracting officers.

Kelly: Working on two sections of Bike/Ped plan. Lighting in tunnels, moving the counters to new locations.

Steve: Kelly should tell Phil BF would like to collect the data.

Steve wants to work with Public Works TTC rep on policies for TTC to take up. Truck routes, parking minimums, etc.
