# **Bike Fitchburg, Inc. Monthly Meeting Minutes**

# Monday, 02/27/2023, 7:00-8:30pm, Oasis Café

- Call to order, roll call, welcome Darryl Steve, Mike, Darryl, Bill, George in attendance. Tony arrived at 7:20
- Meeting Host Spotlight <u>Oasis Café</u> Bike info station Bicycle benefits participant
- Approval of past minutes: Jan 23, 2023
   Steve moved approval.
   Darryl seconded
   Approved unanimously
- 4) Treasurer's report Steve
  - a) Our checking account now contains \$17,613.91. Balanced against that are liabilities to four sub-accounts: the JUST Bikes small grants funds of \$1500, the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund of \$13,155.38, ¡Pick Me Up! registrations of \$0, and AARP Small Dollar, Big Impact grant funds of \$882.66.
  - b) The checking account and the memorial fund liability were reduced by 2312.94 for repair stand, pump, wheel chock, and three Bike Docks (bike racks) from Saris and by \$12.60 for stamps to send tax letters to the memorial fund donors. Other recent checking transactions include \$69.43 for coffee for the Wisconsin Winter Bike Week commuter station, a deposit of \$69.43 from Fitchburg Family Pharmacy to sponsor that event, and \$90 to the Bike League to ship 1300 Smart Cycling Quick Guides to distribution around Fitchburg.
  - c) Our savings account received another \$0.05 in interest and now totals \$1802.04.
  - d) Our net worth has decreased to \$3877.91 (from \$3987.86)
  - e) I filed our free, annual Form 990-N e-postcard with the IRS to certify our annual income is not over \$50,000. Along with our \$25, annual report to the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions each fall, this filing keeps us in good standing as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization with the state and federal governments.
- 5) Progress on 2023 goals
  - a) Volunteer Recruitment Carol

Followup from last Jan: some thoughts on what motivates people to volunteer. Swag, detailed list of well-defined tasks / schedule. How to coordinate with other organizations? No update. Carol not present.

#### b) Update & Re-ratify the Bike/Ped Plan

Mayoral Forum, Wyndham Garden Hotel 11:30-1:00 on Tuesday, March 7 may include candidates' responses to Bike Fitchburg's questions:

- The Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan is the city's road map for improving active transportation policies and infrastructure, but was last adopted in 2017. If you are elected, will you propose, advocate for, and, if passed by the Common Council, sign a budget in 2023 that funds a consultant to update Fitchburg's now-outdated 2017 Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan (estimated cost \$25,000-50,000) in 2024?
- ii) Please speak freely about what you think active transportation (biking of all kinds and walking) means to the city, and whether and how you would work as mayor to make walking and recreational and transportation biking safer, easier, and more fun.

Steve moves BF Secretary to send these two questions to the Mayoral candidates. Darryl seconded. Unanimously approved.

## c) Greenway System - Steve

Steve applied for a Healthy Neighborhoods Initiative of \$15,000 for Toole Design to run a public engagement program to develop a destination hierarchy to develop the signage for the system. BF is operating based on the Dane Co Bicycling Manual. Need public meetings to decide on the destinations to include in the signage. Hierarchy determined based on feedback – primary, secondary, tertiary destinations from each current location.

Can see examples on local Madison trails.

No provision for QR code in Dane Co Bicycling Manual.

### d) **BCycle Expansion** - McKenzie, Lee, Mark

Steve: BCycle opens Mar 15. All stations & bikes for phases 1 and 2 are onhand. Phase 1 will be installed – 55 bikes and 6 stations.

Smart phone, FOB (including free checkout at libraries), cash, RFID cards.

#### e) Better-Connected Trail System

Steve: People for Bikes, Places for Bikes city ratings just came out. Fitchburg is ~87th percentile (100% = best). Based on low stress network connectivity (quiet streets, protected lanes, off-road lanes), and higher stress (bike lanes & shoulders).
