4) Treasurer's report – **Steve**

Our checking account contains \$17,015.99. Balanced against that are inventory of \$810 (Saris Bike Docks) and liabilities to four sub-accounts: the JUST Bikes small grants funds of \$1500, the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund of \$13,335.38, ¡Pick Me Up! registrations of \$15, and AARP Small Dollar, Big Impact grant funds of \$882.66.

Inventory is a new asset account. I bought four Saris Bike Docks on behalf of the Fitchburg Serenity Club, which are on my front porch. Erik Kimble will bring me a check for the \$810 when he picks them

up Wednesday. The \$15 for ¡Pick Me Up! is from Tony's registration. (Tony also donated \$20. Thanks, Tony!) It becomes income when the ride is complete. We have money from three other registrations (the Jetzers and me) and accompanying donations that will be direct deposited to our account in the fullness of time. I also have a birthday fundraiser going for the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund. \$235 has been raised and \$180 of it has already been credited to our account.

Other transactions since our last meeting were \$39 for a repair part for the public repair stand near Adesys, a \$100 donation from Adesys in recognition of our contributions to the community and to the maintenance of the repair stand they donated, and \$63.92 for Kind bars and Nature Valley granola bars to distribute at our Celebrate Trails Day! recreation station.

Our savings account received another \$0.05 in interest and now totals \$1802.13. Our net worth increased to \$3895.08, not including money still to be credited to us from my Birthday fundraiser and new ¡Pick Me Up! Registrations.

Please consider taking these steps:

- Volunteer at Brat Fest and designate Bike Fitchburg as your charity.

We continue to be compliant with federal and state filing requirements for our corporate and IRS 501(c)(3) status.
