2) Special Guests

Amanda Marek Carlson, Executive Director of Tri 4 Schools South Central Wisconsin Amanda will describe her programs and we'll brainstorm how we can collaborate. Amanda:

- Promote positive relationship with physical activity
- Three multisport events per year (2 tri, 1 run bike run)
- After school training programs. 8-10 weeks, at school, w/teacher as coach

- Have a bike trailer full of 25-30 bikes–striders through middle school age. With helmets and pumps. Goal is for trailer to be in use any time there's no snow on the ground

- New operators of the Birdie Derby (formerly Berbee Derby)
- 100% of revenue goes back to schools. Grants for schools. Goal is to help fund PE departments
- Amanda previously worked for Race Day Events. Approached by race director to take over the Derby.
- Wants to collaborate with BF on events

Checking balance \$18,165.34, savings balance \$1802.54.

We are grateful to acknowledge an unrestricted \$500 contribution from Paula Romeo at our last meeting. Since our last meeting we paid \$34.99 to Bike Lane Uprising for a sample of the lights we'll be giving away and \$149.90 to Zoom to extend our subscription for another year. Steve covered the Zoom fee with a \$150 donation. We sold a Bicycle Benefits starter kit to Rutabaga from inventory for \$26.75 and replaced it by purchasing one from Ian. We earned another \$0.09 in interest. Other balances are unchanged: \$250 worth of inventory (durags, Bicycle Benefits and Bicycle Friendly America materials), and the checking account contains \$882.66 for the AARP grant for Greenway System signage and \$13,895.38 in the Kyle Stiegert memorial fund).

Our net worth is now \$5439.84.
